LORD, DO IT AGAIN!

2 Chronicles 7:12-14 (NKJV)

Then the LORD appeared to Solomon by night, and said to him: "I have heard your prayer, and have chosen this place for Myself as a house of sacrifice. ¹³ When I shut up heaven and there is no rain, or command the locusts to devour the land, or send pestilence among My people, ¹⁴ if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

*Is revival the only thing that can save our nation?

I. DO WE NEED REVIVAL AGAIN?

- *6% of adults in the United States have a Biblical Worldview
- *58% of U.S. adults agree with statement :moral truth is up to each individual, there are no moral absolutes that apply to everyone all the time."
- *48% of those in churches agree with the statement above.

George Barna says: "Any society that substitutes humanity's latest and greatest ideas for God's truth and authority is on the fast track to ruin."

Judges 21:25 (MSG)

At that time there was no king in Israel. People did whatever they felt like doing. 2 Timothy 3:1-5 (NLT2)

¹ You should know this, Timothy, that in the last days there will be very difficult times. ² For people will love only themselves and their money. They will be boastful and proud, scoffing at God, disobedient to their parents, and ungrateful. They will consider nothing sacred. ³ They will be unloving and unforgiving; they will slander others and have no self-control. They will be cruel and hate what is good. ⁴ They will betray their friends, be reckless, be puffed up with pride, and love pleasure rather than God. ⁵ They will act religious, but they will reject the power that could make them godly. Stay away from people like that!

II. HOW CAN REVIVAL COME?

Evangelist Gypsy Smith: "Go home, lock yourself in your room, kneel down in the middle of your floor. Draw a chalk mark all around yourself and ask God to start the revival inside that chalk mark. When He has answered your prayer, the revival will be on."

1. Our hearts must desire it and we must search our hearts to see what in us prevents it.

Psalm 139:23-24 (NLT2)

- ²³ Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. ²⁴ Point out anything in me that offends you, and lead me along the path of everlasting life.
- 2. Revival may be instigated by a deep concern for a moral crisis or event.
- 3. A revival may employ methods which aren't transferred to another revival.
- 4. Genuine revivals produce joy and may be accompanied by extraordinary events.
- 5. Prayer is an absolute necessity for revival to occur.

III. THE RECIPE FOR REVIVAL

2 Chronicles 7:14 (AMP)

If My people, who are called by My name, shall humble themselves, pray, seek, crave, *and* require of necessity My face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven, forgive their sin, and heal their land.

- *Manchester, KY revival in 2004 resulted in:
- 1. Reduction in crime and corruption
- 2. Economic conditions improved and poverty greatly reduced.
- 3. Political leaders publicly acknowledged sin and have renewed dependence on God
- 4. Decline in divorce, bankruptcy, and suicide.
- 5. Christian volunteerism to help care for the community.
- 6. Many local drug dealers accepted Jesus as Savior and substance abuse greatly reduced.
- 7. Wildlife and animals has returned to the land.

"God tabernacled here."
