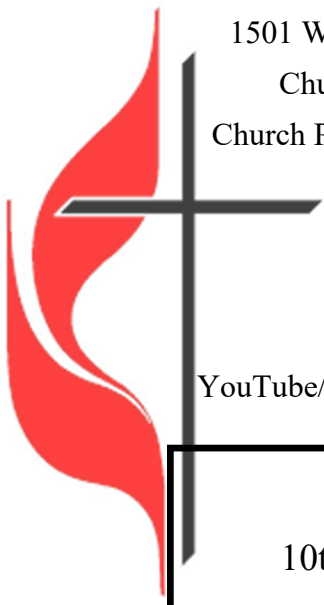

## **Jeremiah 29:10-11 (NLT2)**

<sup>10</sup>This is what the LORD says: “You will be in Babylon for seventy years. But then I will come and do for you all the good things I have promised, and I will bring you home again. <sup>11</sup>For I know the plans I have for you,” says the LORD. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.

## **I. GOD CREATED YOU**

### **Romans 1:20 (NLT2)**

For ever since the world was created, people have seen the earth and sky. Through everything God made, they can clearly see his invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature. So they have no excuse for not knowing God.

## **II. GOD MOLDS YOU**

### **Ephesians 2:8-10 (NLT2)**

<sup>8</sup> God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can’t take credit for this; it is a gift from God. <sup>9</sup> Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. <sup>10</sup> For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.

\*God forms us like the Potter forms the clay.

\*We grow through studying the Bible, praying daily, and attending church regularly.

\*Remember both who we are and whose we are.

## **III. GOD CALLS US ACCORDING TO HIS PURPOSE**

### **Romans 12:7-11 (NLT2)**

<sup>7</sup> If your gift is serving others, serve them well. If you are a teacher, teach well.

<sup>8</sup> If your gift is to encourage others, be encouraging. If it is giving, give generously. If God has given you leadership ability, take the responsibility seriously. And if you have a gift for showing kindness to others, do it gladly. <sup>9</sup> Don’t just pretend to love others. Really love them. Hate what is wrong. Hold tightly to what is good. <sup>10</sup> Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honoring each other. <sup>11</sup> Never be lazy, but work hard and serve the Lord enthusiastically.

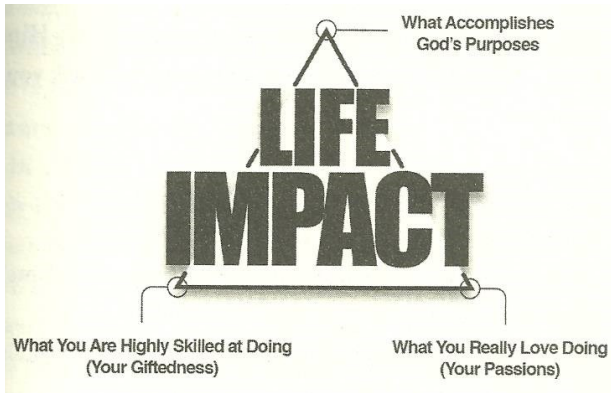
