HOW TO OVERCOME TEMPTATION

James 1:13-15 (NKJV)

¹³ Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. ¹⁴ But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. ¹⁵ Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death.

I. TEMPTATION IS BEING ENTICED BY SATAN

James 1:13-14 (NLT2)

And remember, when you are being tempted, do not say, "God is tempting me." God is never tempted to do wrong, and he never tempts anyone else. ¹⁴Temptation comes from our own desires, which entice us and drag us away.

*Temptation is being drawn away by our own selfish desires & enticed to do wrong.

*Greek word for enticed means to lure with a bait.

*Satan lures us with temptations and knows our weaknesses.

*Temptation isn't sin. Sin is acting on temptation and entertaining impure and wrong thoughts.

II. TEMPTATION CAN BE OVERCOME

1 Corinthians 10:13 (NLT2)

¹³ The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure.

Matthew 4:2-11 (MSG)

² Jesus prepared for the Test by fasting forty days and forty nights. That left him, of course, in a state of extreme hunger, ³ which the Devil took advantage of in the first test: "Since you are God's Son, speak the word that will turn these stones into loaves of bread." ⁴ Jesus answered by quoting Deuteronomy: "It takes more than bread to stay alive. It takes a steady stream of words from God's mouth." ⁵ For the second test the Devil took him to the Holy City. He sat him on top of the Temple and said, ⁶ "Since you are God's Son, jump." The Devil goaded him by quoting Psalm 91: "He has placed you in the care of angels. They will catch you so that you won't so much as stub your toe on a stone." ⁷ Jesus countered with another citation from Deuteronomy: "Don't you dare test the Lord your God." ⁸ For the third test, the Devil took him on the peak of a huge mountain. He gestured expansively, pointing out all the earth's kingdoms, how glorious they all were. ⁹ Then he said, "They're yours—lock, stock, and barrel. Just go down on your knees and worship me, and they're yours." ¹⁰ Jesus' refusal was curt: "Beat it, Satan!" He backed his rebuke with a third quotation from Deuteronomy: "Worship the Lord your God, and only him. Serve him with absolute single-heartedness." ¹¹ The Test was over. The Devil left. And in his place, angels! Angels came and took care of Jesus' needs.

*Satan used temptations that appealed to the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, & the pride of life.

- *Jesus quoted God's Word to combat Satan.
- *Jesus rebuked and resisted Satan: "Get lost"

*Steps to overcome Satan's temptation:

-Recognize the sin that one is tempted to commit. Don't justify it.

-Take the Word of God and find a Bible verse to overcome the temptation.

-Choose to glorify God by not succumbing to the temptation.

-Consider this: what will be the consequences if you sin.

III. TEMPTATION CAN LEAD TO SIN

*In II Samuel 11, King David does not lead his army in battle as is the custom.

Arno Gaebelein: "He had been in self-indulgence and was self-satisfied with his great achievements. The spirit which characterized later Nebuchadnezzar when he walked in his palace puffed up with

pride, which preceded his great humiliation, was no doubt David's spirit also. Had he remained in the presence of the Lord, humble and depending on Him, as we saw him after the Lord had spoken through Nathan this awful sin would not have happened."

James 1:15 (NLT2)

These desires give birth to sinful actions. And when sin is allowed to grow, it gives birth to death.

*David commits adultery with Bathsheba and plots the death of her husband.

*Temptation leads to sinful action which produces spiritual death.

*David admits his sin when the prophet Nathan confronts him saying "You are the man."

*Steps to restoration when one sins.

1. Repent and Rest. Repentance is true sorrow for personal sin. Admit it to God. Is. 30:15

Prayer: "Lord, I hate the fact that I have sinned, yet I alone am responsible and am willing to turn from temptation and trust in You. Lord, instead of doing what I want, I will rest and wait to know Your will."

2. Return. Cry out for help from God and He will hear you and answer. **Isaiah 30:19 Prayer:** "Lord, I turn to You for help, and I thank You for hearing and answering my call."

3. Receive. Listen to Him in prayer and the Word and He will show you His path. Is 30:21

Prayer: "Lord, I am ready to receive Your road map and to walk on the road that you choose for me"

4. Recover. Surrender to God & you will not be in bondage to sin. Isaiah 30:22 Prayer:

"Lord, I am getting rid of everything that has had control over me so that You can be in control of my life."

5. Rejoice. God always blesses thos who live in communion with Him. Isaiah 30:23-26 Prayer:

"Lord, thank You for healing my heart and promising to accomplish Your purpose for me."
