THE SOURCE OF UNITY

John 17:1-5 (NKJV)

¹ Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You, ² as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him. ³ And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent. ⁴ I have glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me to do. ⁵ And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

John 8:44 (MSG)

You're from your father, the Devil, and all you want to do is please him. He was a killer from the very start. He couldn't stand the truth because there wasn't a shred of truth in him. When the Liar speaks, he makes it up out of his lying nature and fills the world with lies.

I. THE DREAM OF UNITY

- *Martin Luther King: I have a dream...
- *Our hope is in Jesus Christ.

John 10:10 (NKJV)

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

*Where does unity come from?

II. THE SOURCE OF UNITY IS GOD

- *We don't worship three gods.
- *We don't worship one God who takes on three roles. *God is a Trinity or Tri-unity.
- *There are hints of the Trinity in the Old Testament.

Deuteronomy 6:4-5 (NKJV)

"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD *is* one! ⁵ You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.

- *Yahweh is singular (one). Elohim is plural (God is three). So read it: Yahweh (one God) our Elohim (Trinity) is one Yahweh.
- *The New Testament reveals the Trinity: the baptism of Jesus, the baptismal formula, and Paul's benediction.

John 10:30 (NLT2)

The Father and I are one."

*The oneness spoken of in the Scriptures is not of personage, but of counsel, fellowship, agreement, purpose, vision, work, love and glory.

III. THE BENEFICIARY OF GOD'S UNITY

John 17:21-23 (NLT2)

I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me. ²² "I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one. ²³ I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me.

Dr. Ben Witherington: "Did Jesus believe He was the Son of God, the anointed one of God? The answer is yes. Did he see himself as the Son of Man? Yes, that's the way He viewed Himself. Did He believe that anybody less than God could save the world? No, I don't believe He did."

Philippians 4:8 (NLT2)

And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise.
