UNITY IN THE SPIRIT

Ephesians 4:1-6 (NKJV)

¹ I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, ² with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love,

³ endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

⁴ There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

James 4:1 (NLT2)

I. UNITY IN THE SPIRIT

Ephesians 2:19-21 (NLT2)

¹⁹So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people. You are members of God's family. ²¹We are carefully joined together in him, becoming a holy temple for the Lord.

Ephesians 4:1-5 (NLT2)

- ¹ Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. ² Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love. ³ Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace.
- *Walk in humility.
- *Be gentle or meek.
- *Be patient with one another.
- *Love others in spite of their faults.
- *Strive for the unity in the Spirit.

II. MAINTAINING UNITY IN THE CHURCH

Ephesians 4:4-6 (NLT2)

- ⁴ For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future. ⁵ There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, ⁶ and one God and Father, who is over all and in all and living through all.
- *One body refers to the whole universal church, every believer.
- *One Spirit is the Holy Spirit.
- *We have a common hope and confident about eternity with God.
- *One Lord is Jesus, the Head of the church.
- *One faith is our faith in Him that saved us.
- *One baptism refers to water baptism and it identifies us with Jesus Christ.
- *One God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all.

John 17:21-23 (NLT2)

- ²¹ I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me. ²² "I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one. ²³ I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me.
- *Unity isn't uniformity.
- *Unity honors Christ and His mission.
- *Unity of believers brings glory to God.

III. THE UNITY OF THE MISSION

Ephesians 4:11-13 (NLT2)

^{11°}Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. ¹² Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ. ¹³ This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.

- 1. Unity and maturity come with praying together.
- 2. Unity and evangelism.
- 3. Unity and serving.

James 3:13-18 (NLT2)

¹³ If you are wise and understand God's ways, prove it by living an honorable life, doing good works with the humility that comes from wisdom. ¹⁴ But if you are bitterly jealous and there is selfish ambition in your heart, don't cover up the truth with boasting and lying. ¹⁵ For jealousy and selfishness are not God's kind of wisdom. Such things are earthly, unspiritual, and demonic. ¹⁶ For wherever there is jealousy and selfish ambition, there you will find disorder and evil of every kind. ¹⁷ But the wisdom from above is first of all pure. It is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others. It is full of mercy and good deeds. It shows no favoritism and is always sincere. ¹⁸ And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.
