WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A CHRISTIAN?

Acts 11:19-26 (NKJV)

¹⁹ Now those who were scattered after the persecution that arose over Stephen traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to no one but the Jews only. ²⁰ But some of them were men from Cyprus and Cyrene, who, when they had come to Antioch, spoke to the Hellenists, preaching the Lord Jesus. ²¹ And the hand of the Lord was with them, and a great number believed and turned to the Lord. ²² Then news of these things came to the ears of the church in Jerusalem, and they sent out Barnabas to go as far as Antioch. ²³ When he came and had seen the grace of God, he was glad, and encouraged them all that with purpose of heart they should continue with the Lord. ²⁴ For he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And a great many people were added to the Lord. ²⁵ Then Barnabas departed for Tarsus to seek Saul. ²⁶ And when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. So it was that for a whole year they assembled with the church and taught a great many people. And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch.

Acts 1:8 (NKJV)

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

1 John 5:13 (NLT2)

I have written this to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know you have eternal life.

What does it mean to be a Christian? Four tests from the Gospel of John:

I. TEST #1: CONFESS JESUS AS LORD

1 John 4:15 (NLT2)

All who confess that Jesus is the Son of God have God living in them, and they live in God.

II. TEST #2: OBEY THE COMMANDS OF GOD

1 John 5:3 (NLT2)

Loving God means keeping his commandments, and his commandments are not burdensome.

John 14:15 (MSG)

"If you love me, show it by doing what I've told you.

III. TEST #3: BUILD FRIENDSHIPS WITH BELIEVERS

1 John 5:1 (NLT2)

Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has become a child of God. And everyone who loves the Father loves his children, too.

IV. TEST #4: GROW IN LOVE FOR OTHERS

1 John 2:9-11 (NLT2)

If anyone claims, "I am living in the light," but hates a Christian brother or

sister, that person is still living in darkness. ¹⁰ Anyone who loves another brother or sister is living in the light and does not cause others to stumble. ¹¹ But anyone who hates another brother or sister is still living and walking in darkness. Such a person does not know the way to go, having been blinded by the darkness.

John Wesley: "Love suffereth long," or is longsuffering. If thou love thy neighbour for God's sake, thou wilt bear long with his infirmities: If he want wisdom, thou wilt pity and not despise him: If he be in error, thou wilt mildly endeavour to recover him, without any sharpness or reproach: If he be overtaken in a fault, thou wilt labour to restore him in the spirit of meekness.... "Love is kind." In his tongue is the law of kindness. The same is impressed on all his actions. And if you love your neighbour as yourself, you will not be able to prefer yourself before him. Nay, you will not be able to despise any one, any more than to hate him.

[Nay, you will think every man better than yourself.]

Consider the four tests to determine if you are a Christian:

- 1. Have you ever confessed Jesus is Lord and ask Him to forgive your sins?
- 2. I delight in obeying Him and keeping His commandments such as the Ten Commandments and other commands in the Bible
 - 3. Do you have Christian friends? Can you call them and ask for prayer and for help in your Christian walk?
 - 4. Are you growing in love as outlined in John Wesley's comments about love?
