

NOAH, THE MAN WHO WALKED WITH GOD Genesis 6:1-9 (NKJV)

¹ Now it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born to them, ² that the sons of God saw the daughters of men, that they *were* beautiful; and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose. ³ And the LORD said, "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he *is* indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years." ⁴ There were giants on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of men and they bore *children* to them. Those *were* the mighty men who *were* of old, men of renown. ⁵ Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, and *that* every intent of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually. ⁶ And the LORD was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. ⁷ So the LORD said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them." ⁸ But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD. ⁹ This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with God.

I. NOAH'S COMMAND FROM GOD

Genesis 6:14-15 (NLT2)

"Build a large boat from cypress wood and waterproof it with tar, inside and out. Then construct decks and stalls throughout its interior.¹⁵ Make the boat 450 feet long, 75 feet wide, and 45 feet high."

II. NOAH, THE PREACHER

2 Peter 2:5 (AMP)

⁵ And He spared not the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a preacher of righteousness, with seven other persons, when He brought a flood upon the world of ungodly [people].

*God is the same God in the Old Testament and New Testament. *God is filled with compassion and patience.

Psalm 86:15 (NLT2)

But you, O Lord, are a God of compassion and mercy, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love and faithfulness.

Genesis 6:22 (NLT2)

So Noah did everything exactly as God had commanded him.

*Noah was faithful and courageous

Genesis 6:5-9 (AMP)

⁵ The Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination *and* intention of all human thinking was only evil continually. ⁶ And the Lord regretted that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved at heart. ⁷ So the Lord said, I will destroy, blot out, *and* wipe away mankind, whom I have created from the face of the ground—not only man, [but] the beasts and the creeping things and the birds of the air—for it grieves Me *and* makes Me regretful that I have made them. ⁸ But Noah found grace (favor) in the eyes of the Lord. ⁹ This is the history of the generations of Noah. No-ah was a just *and* righteous man, blameless *in* his [evil] generation; Noah walked [in habitual fellowship] with God.

*Noah found the grace of God.
